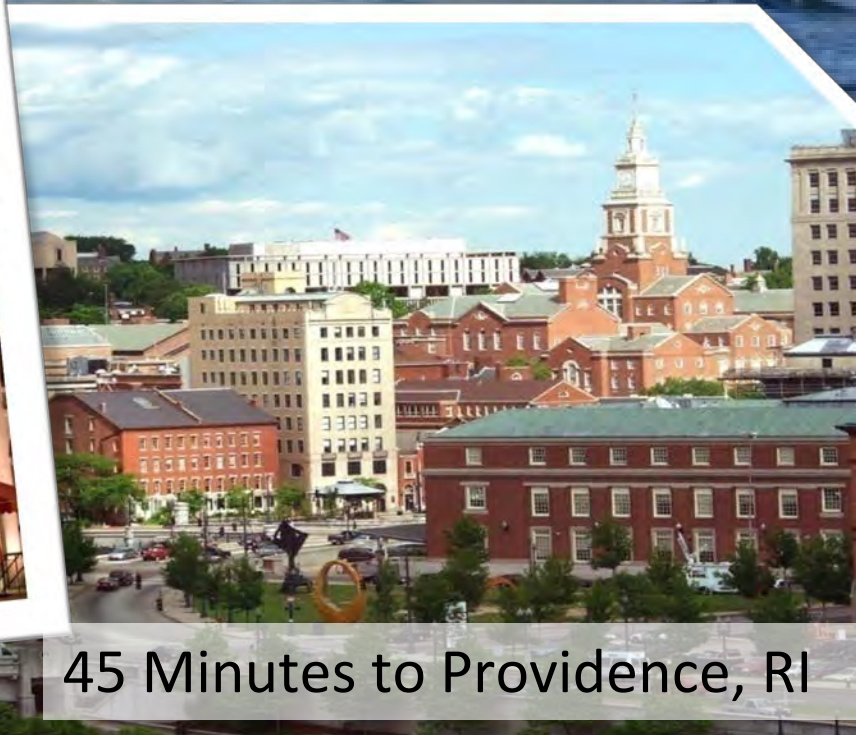

URI Taiwan Summer Institute

The URI Taiwan Summer Institute offers students the opportunity for personal exploration and study in an American college environment.

This program is ideal for students interested in maximizing cultural and linguistic skills in an Anglophone country.

The goals of the Summers Institutes are:

- To provide students with a learning environment that will enhance their understanding of American culture
- To offer technical training to students in the common area of engineering and business administration
- To provide English training to students through an intensive English language training program.



URI Summer Institutes

The Summer Language and Culture Immersion program will consist of three components::



Four-week English training and summer lodging on the URI Kinston Campus. Through weekly lectures and conversations, students will continue to develop their conversational skills and improve grammar usage and pronunciation.



Four-week technical training in fundamentals and advancements in entrepreneurship, business and society, logistics, accounting, and sustainability through lectures and hands-on experiences.



The cultural component, which includes a cultural orientation and visits to historical sites, will enable students to experience selected aspects of American culture, firsthand.

English Course



The **primary focus** of this course is **oral communication**.

Course content emphasizes an introduction to American culture and intercultural communication.

Students build fluency in English by participating in oral discussions based on course readings and giving oral presentations on a variety of cultural topics..

Students will take this course two hours a day, four days a week.

Upon completion, students will earn two-credits toward their BS degree in their institution.

English Course



In addition to building English fluency, students enhance intercultural awareness by reflecting on differences between America and their own country

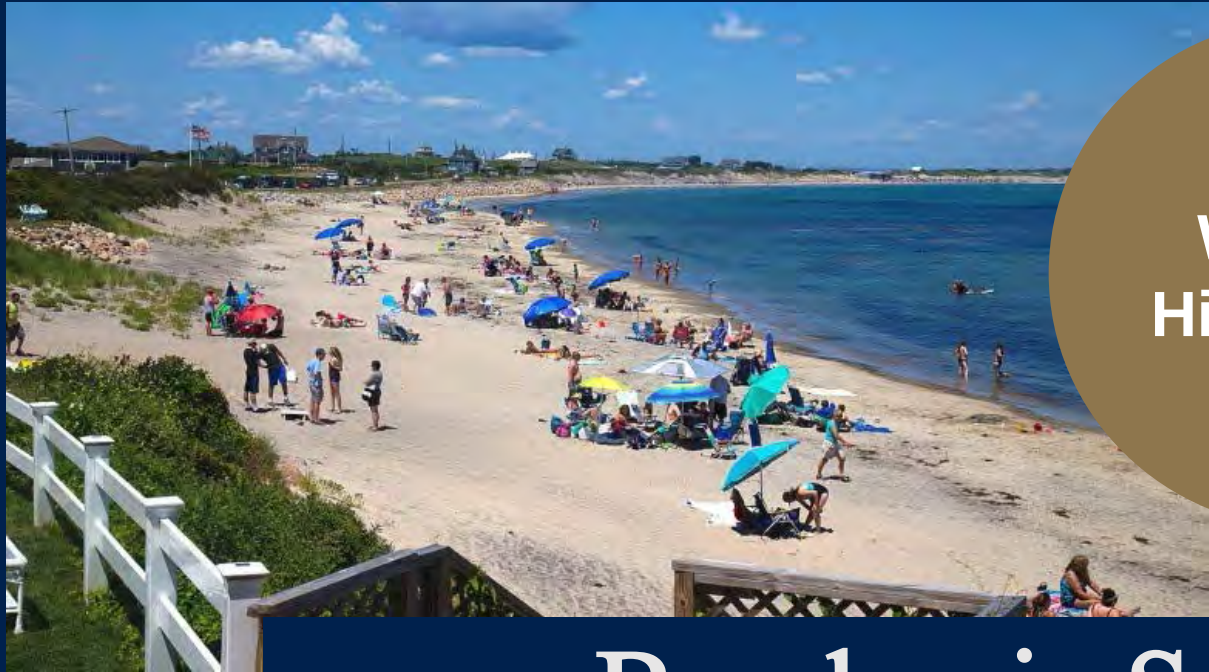

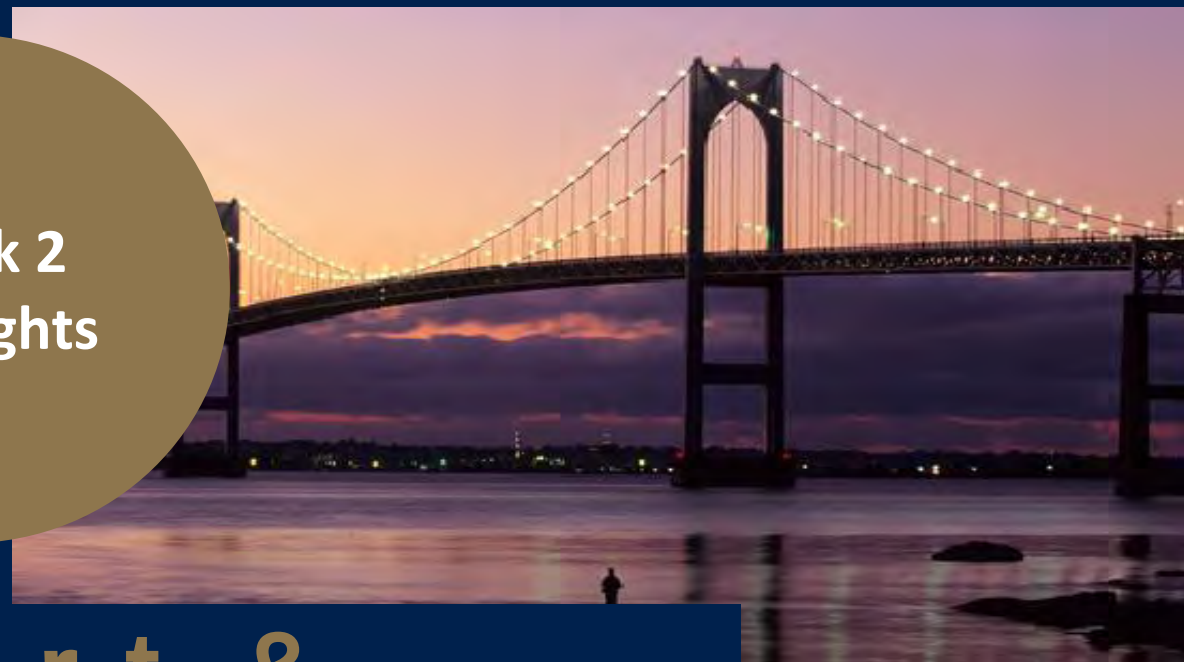

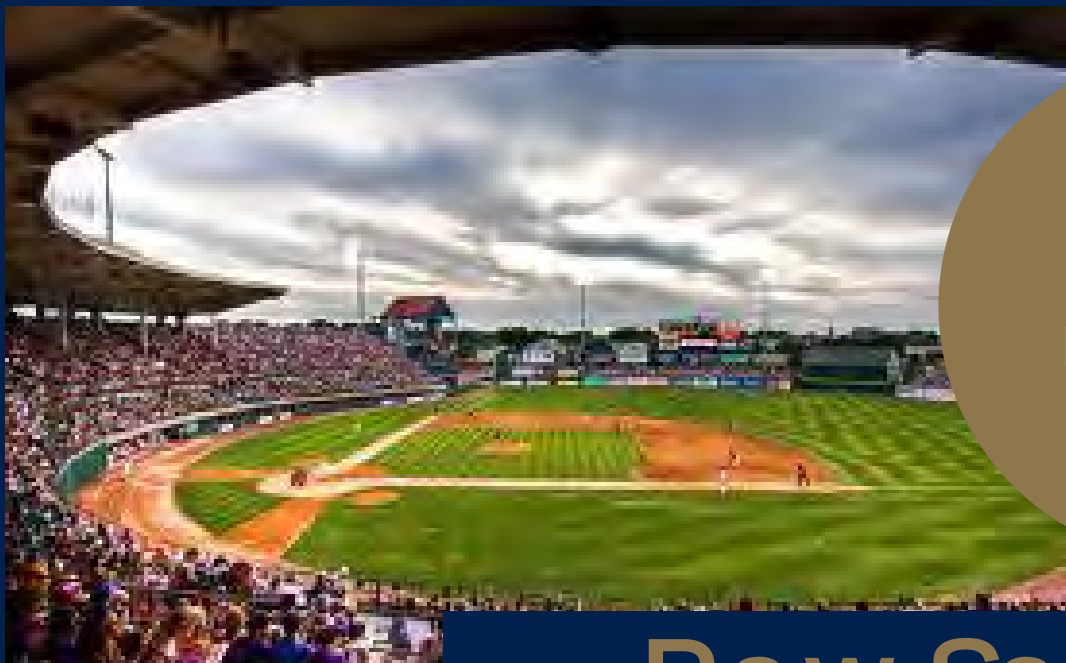
